Special Scoring 7: 14th September 2013

"BLAUE / BLAU-GELBE BAND DER FLENSBURGER FÖRDE"

(Blue and Blue-Yellow Ribbon of the Flensburg Fjord)

1. Start: Saturday 14th September 2013, 10:00 hrs
2. Classes: all boats including those without a measurement certificate that correspond with the security regulations of the Notice of Race. All boats with at least 12.0 m LOA, that register for Race 6 and/ or the Nord Stream Race 2013, automatically take part in this race, free of charge.
"Blaues Band" ("Blue Ribbon") for the fastest Mono-hull-Yacht according to elapsed time that has its home port at the Flensburg Fjord. A certificate of the home yacht club situated at the Flensburg fjord has to be presented. The final decision about the admission of a yacht remains with the Organizing Authority.- "Blau-Gelbes Band" (Blue-Yellow Ribbon) for the fastest foreign Mono-hull-Yacht according to elapsed time, "Gelbes Band" (Yellow Ribbon) for the fastest Multi-hull. This Race will be started together with Race 6.
3. Courses: Race 1 consists of races with Windward/Leeward-Courses of about 4-7 nm. The courses will be laid out on Flensburg's Inner-fjord and/or on Flensburg's Outer- fjord off Holnis.
Races 2-7 are inshore/offshore races along buoys of the navigable waters of Flensburg Fjord /Kleiner Belt (Little Belt). The start will take place on Flensburg Innerfjord outside Glücksburg harbour from the starting-vessel.

Race 10: Flensburg-Cup 07th /08th September 2013

Classes: **Melges 24, X-99, Platu 25, 806**

This series takes place along with Race 1.

1. Start: 07th September 2013, 11:00 hrs

A windward/leeward- course will be laid out of about 4-6 nm length, scoring according to Low-Point-System. If 4 or more races are concluded there will be one discard.

Additional Rules for Races 1- 7

The races are governed by the general rules for the 103rd Flensburger Fördewoche with the following amendments: Rules of the German Sailing Federation (DSV) for juveniles for ORCint. and ORC Club Races: The crew-weight may be up to 50 kg higher than listed in the rating certificate, as long as there are crewmembers on board who did not complete their 15th year of their life before May 1st of the current regatta-season.

Entries: Entries that are tied on additional conditions by the participants will be rejected.

Classes: The classification will be made by the Organizing Authority whose decision will be final. The Organizing Authority reserves the right to execute changes that appear necessary due to late entries or new insights up to 12 hours before the first start. These will be posted at the notice board.

ORCint.: a photocopy of a valid rating certificate has to be presented at least 4 working days before the first start. For the participants a later change in rating will not be possible until the end of the series.
The classification or class organization will be made according to the "Offshore Handicap (sec/m) GPH"

Scoring System:

- a) Windward/ Leeward races with nearly identical parts (short offset courses at the windward mark are permitted): selected Course, Windward/ Leeward
- b) Other Windward/ Leeward races: Performance Curve
- c) Other races: time on time simple offshore

2.1. Classification

The following classifications may be regarded as guidelines:

ORCint. 1: - 581, 9 GPH

ORCint. 2: 582 - 637 GPH

ORCint. ¾: 637,1 - GPH

It is explicitly stated that the Organizing Authority may diverge from these guidelines in the case of individual boats, especially because of their hull length.

2.2.

In case of a large number of entries an additional sub-classification in so called "A" and "B"- classes can be made.

ORC-Club:

Classification: a classification will take place according to Offshore Handicap (sec/m) GPH

Scoring: will be published in the sailing instructions or by posting on the notice board.

One-Design classes: yachts will sail without *compensation* and will be scored according to elapsed time. for the registration of such classes at least 5 entries per class are required. Owners of yachts, who want to sail without *compensation* are asked, to mark this in their entry form at the corresponding box.

Starting flag: the numeral pennant of the start has to be shown at the back stay according to the list of participants. The *pennants* shall have dimensions appropriate to the size of the yacht. This applies only to ORCint., ORC-Club and Nautor Swan.

Security category: Races 1 - 7 = Category 4. The "Security Guidelines" for the equipment and security of sailing yachts of the "Kreuzerabteilung des DSV" (German Sailing Federation), latest edition, apply for all yachts that register according to ORCint., ORC- Club or Nautor Swan.

We are especially pleased to welcome the crews of the 5 Gazprom SWAN 60-Yachts as our guests, before they will take part in the "Nord Stream Race" from Glücksburg to St. Petersburg after the Flensburger Fördewoche. Together with the Flensburger Yacht-Service we have planned again two attractive evening events exclusively for the Swan Sailors that will take place in our "Kleine Bootshalle". For participants who are berthing in the "Sonwik Marina" for reasons of draught, a Shuttle-Service to Glücksburg will be offered.

Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the
 - Racing Rules of the ISAF - latest edition
 - General Rules and regulation of the Notice of Race of the 103rd Flensburger Fördewoche if Not changed by this NoR for the SWAN Baltic Sea Challenge.
- 1.2 „Sicherheitsrichtlinien für die Ausrüstung und Sicherheit von Segelyachten der Kreuzerabteilung des DSV - Kategorie 4" (Safety Regulations for Equipment and Security of Yachts by the Kreuzerabteilung of the DSV-Category 4) will apply
- 1.3 Races will be sailed under ORC-Club rules and scoring.

Eligibility, Classes, rating:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all NAUTOR SWAN yachts - measured or without measurement certificate
- 2.2 Yachts entered without valid ORC-Club rating certificate will receive an estimated rating for these races only, by the organizers which can not be disputed.

Closing date: 29th August 2013

Entry fee: up to 44 ft length 300,-- € (total series)
More than 44 ft length 400,-- € (total series)

The entry fee includes the invitation to the SWAN-Dinner at the “Kleine Bootshalle” for skipper and crew (food and two drinks (beer/soft drinks))

Races: The SWAN Baltic Sea Challenge consists out of 3 races as follows:

Race A: **hanseboot Cup**, 12th September 2013

1. Start: 10.00 hrs

Race B: **17111 Transit-Logistic Cup**, 13th September 2013

1. Start: 13.30 hrs

Race C: **Flensburger Pilsener-Cup**, 14th September 2013

1. Start: 10.00 hrs

All Swan Yachts are invited to participate under ORCint. or ORC-Club scoring of the Races 3, 5, 6 and 7 at a special entry fee of 50,-- € for each additional entry provided the yacht has the required measurement certificate.

Prizes: There will be prizes for the best 2 boats of each race and prizes on total points of the complete SWAN Baltic Sea Challenge according to rules of Flensburger Fördewoche.

Mooring: All participating yachts can be moored free of charge at the yacht-harbour of the Flensburger Segel-Club, Glücksburg (draft limit: 3.50 m) or at Marina Sonwik.

Social events: **11th September 2013, 20:00 hrs**, SWAN Baltic Sea Challenge 2013 Opening-Dinner, “Kleine Bootshalle”, Glücksburg-Quellental. Food and two drinks (beer/soft drinks) are included in the entry fee for skipper and crew. For accompanying persons additional vouchers can be bought at the race office.

General Rules for all events of the 103rd Flensburger Fördewoche in this Notice of Races

- Rules:**
1. The Regatta will be governed by the following rules (latest edition):
 - The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS),
 - The National Prescription of DSV,
 - The Class Rules for measurement, equipment and propulsion,
 - This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
 2. The Sailing Instructions may partly alter the RRS and this Notice of Race. The changes of RRS will be published and specified in the sailing instructions
 3. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will only be made in writing and posted at the official Notice Boards, located close by the Race Office in the front of the FSC-Clubhouse.
 4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence. For the German National prescription, the NoR and SI the German text will take precedence.
 5. The person in charge shall either have a valid sailing license of the DSV, "Youth sailor license", "Sport sailor license" or a valid official license prescribed or recommended for the sailing area, issued by the DSV by order of the government department for traffic, construction and home development. Members of other national federations shall have an adequate sailing license of their national authority.
 6. The Race Committee will subject boats to random measurement checks. An appointed committee will check the observance of the rules and the safety equipment. In alteration of RRS 63.1 boats not complying with the rules will be penalized without a protest hearing.
 7. A change of the entered sail-number will be allowed until registration. Boats shall use the sail-number of their boats measurement certificate, only.
- Entries:**
1. The closing date will be shown separately at each event
 2. Eligible boats may enter using either:
 - a) Internet: Please use the online entry on www.manage2sail.com.
The organizers shall be authorized to collect the entry fee electronically.
 - or
 - b) Paper Mail: A complete and signed official form shall be sent to the organizers.
 3. If entered the entry fee shall be paid, even if the entry is being cancelled after the closing date or the boat does not show up. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- Advertising:**
- a) The ISAF Regulation 20 shall apply
 - b) When checking in, each boat may receive bow numbers and/or logos of Sponsors. These numbers/ logos shall be fixed clearly visible on the boats. Please see the Sailing Instructions.
- Courses:**
- The courses will be defined in the sailing instructions.
- Haul-out Restrictions:**
- Keel boats shall not be hauled out between preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta without the agreement of the jury.
- Insurance:**
- Each participating boat shall be insured with valid (and for the racing area suitable) third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 € per event or the equivalent.
- Scoring:**
- The Low-Point-System of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. If 4 or more races are completed one race shall be discarded
- Berthing:**
- Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the yacht harbour. The port regulations of the FSC have to be followed

Radio Communication:

Except in case of emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. VHF Channel 15 or 17 might be used for nonofficial information during the races.

Disclaimer of Liability

The responsibility for the decision of the person in charge to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with him, to that extent he also takes the responsibility for his crew. The helmsman is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of his crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe condition of the registered boat. In cases of Force Majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. In these cases there does not exist any liability for compensation of the organizer to the participant. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary respectively material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer no matter because of which cause in law, for material and property damages of all kinds and their consequences that arise to the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event resulting from a conduct of the organizer, his representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused willfully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs, in cases of simple negligence the liability of the organizer is limited to foreseeable damages, typically occurring. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff - employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who provide or drive salvage-, safety- or rescue vessels or assist with their use - from the individual liability for damages, as well as also all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event. The effective racing rules of the ISAF, the class rules as well as the regulations of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized. The German law applies.
